PUPPY CLASS POLICIES AND GUIDELINES—Please Read, Initial, and Sign when registering for classes

All classes at Come-Play-Stay (CPS) use the most advanced reward-based training techniques. Food and clickers will be used. We do not use nor allow corrective techniques (no force or intimidation) in our classes.

Puppy Class Policies

___ Complete payment will secure your class reservation. We accept credit/debit cards or cash. Payment may be called in 970-226-6526 x 6 or dropped off at Come-Play-Stay! at South Mesa—3801 S. Mason St., Fort Collins, CO 80525

___ All puppies must be between 8-18 weeks of age in order to participate in puppy classes. Puppies must be 14 weeks or younger when they begin puppy class in order to complete the series. All puppies must have veterinary proof of current vaccinations prior to the start of class. All puppies must have had 8 or 9 week vaccinations (distemper/parvo and bordetella) and be up to date for their age in order to participate in class.

___ All people registering for classes taught at CPS must sign and return class policies and waiver prior to the start of class.

___ No sick animals should be brought to class. If your puppy has experienced vomiting, diarrhea, or fever, they must be clear of all symptoms for three days prior to returning to CPS. Any puppy that has been treated for anything contagious may not return to CPS unless they are cleared by their veterinarian.

___ DO NOT take your puppy to dog parks while they are enrolled in CPS puppy services.

___ Class fees are non-refundable unless one of the following applies:

- 1) You or your dog experience a situation that keeps you from attending class (i.e. illness)
- 2) You are not satisfied with the class. You must verbally express your dissatisfaction to your instructor within 24 hours following your first class.

___ It is your responsibility to clean up after your animal both in and outside of the facility. Delinquency with this can lead to class dismissal without refund.

___ Harsh treatment **will not** be tolerated! You will receive a warning if you are being perceived as being harsh. If harsh treatment continues, you will be dismissed from class without a refund.

Class Guidelines – Please Sign and Initial

_____ Please notify your instructor of any behavior concerns or aggression issues prior to the start of the first class to ensure that your situation can be accommodated in a group setting.

_____ Please have your dog on leash before unloading from your vehicle and keep them on leash at all times unless instructed otherwise. Owner shall have their animal under control to the best of their ability. If owner is concerned with entering the building and having the dog under control, they should speak with their instructor prior to the start of class so that arrangements may be made.

_____ **Please do not** allow your dog to approach another dog unless instructed to do so by class instructor. Many of the animals coming to training class are dealing with behavior issues and learning to be around other dogs. Please be considerate of others and their animals. Let's keep this a safe and fun experience!

_____ Animals should be allowed to relieve themselves prior to entering the building. You may use the graveled or grass areas. It is the owner's responsibility to clean up after their animal!

_____ It is preferred that only one person train the dog in class. However, family is encouraged to attend and observe classes so they can work with the dog outside of class. Avoid having a person that has not attended classes fill-in for regular class participant.

_____ No children under the age of 16 may participate solely in class without parent supervision.

_____ If young children must accompany you to class **please do not** allow them to approach other dogs, run, play, or make excessive noise in order to avoid putting them at risk of injury from animals that are unsure of children.

_____ Sorry, no canine visitors will be allowed.

_____ Please make arrangements with your instructor if you have to miss a class so that you can get necessary class materials and will understand what is going to happen in the next class. Normal class times will not be used to catch people up on topics that were missed.

_____ If you have physical limitations please make sure that your instructor is aware of this prior to the start of class. If at any time during class you are physically unable to complete the assigned task, please speak up.

_____ If you do not understand, just ask. Your happiness is very important to us!

_____ Refrain from feeding other people's dogs. We are working with our animals and teaching them to focus on us. This is difficult if someone's treats are better than yours and vice versa.

_____ Wear comfortable shoes and clothing so you have the ability to move around with your dog.

_____ Please focus on your dog during class. Remember that your dogs need 100% from you.
